Ensure that my child comes to school daily in the required mandatory uniforms. Provide a written excuse when my child is absent upon his/her return to school or within 2 days. Promote and support the guidelines for acceptable behavior as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct. Spend quality time with my child daily by reading together and reviewing any additional lessons that are sent home by his/her teacher. Help my child in the best way I know how and do whatever it takes for him/her to learn. Work **respectfully** with the school personnel to resolve any conflicts or disagreements regarding my child or the school. Attend mandatory scheduled conferences regarding my child's academic and behavior. I understand if my child qualifies for tutoring based on deficient grades and assessment scores, that he/she may receive an invitation to attend after school tutoring or Saturday school. Attend ALL 3 Parent/Teacher Data Conferences. I understand that I must attend 2 school meetings per quarter: 1 being the Parent/Teacher Data Conference and a school wide meeting (Ex: Parent Roundtable or Open House). I **COMMIT** to providing and contributing to a safe and professional environment for my child, teachers, administrators and community members by committing to communicate with any and all staff members in a professional manner, refraining from using excessively loud, confrontational language/body language, threats, and inappropriate language at any time.
