Finance Report – Greg Thompson (GT3) and Carmen Fondren, Finance Mgr., Promise Academy

- Promise Academy Financial Update was distributed and discussed.
 - o Hollywood Year-to- Date Through 12-31-2023 Financials:
 - Lower than expected enrollment has contributed to decrease in per pupil funding
 - ESSER 3.0 will rollover to FY24
 - Cash balance: We haven't collected all ESSER; cash will climb
 - We are holding on to our line of credit until we receive more reimbursements
 - Forecasted deficit: Hollywood will be close to breakeven when staffing expenses are adjusted.
 - o Spring Hill Year-to- Date Through 12-31-2023 Financials :
 - Surplus at Spring Hill will increase due to ESSER funding

• Due to strong cash position at Spring Hill, we will pay down some of the line of credit

- TN Public Charter School Commission just made ESSER 3.0 budget available so we will be submitting reimbursements
- Budget Summary: Surplus will be reduced by staffing expense shifting
- Spring Hill is doing well against budget
- Currently working on 2023 audit

Old Business – Dr. Patrick Washington

- Promise Academy Spring Hill has been officially accepted into the TN Public Charter School Commission. The Commission has also renewed the charter for 10 years.
- Promise Academy's updated website has been launched.

New Business – Dr. Patrick Washington

• Selected The Marston Group, PLC as our new auditor

- Partnered with Power Solutions, LLC to focus on student recruitment, school promotion and brand awareness
- Summer Boost (summer school): Kristen McClasson presented a plan to apply for grant to fund summer school for at least 60 students per grade (rising 1^{st} rising 5^{th})
- Retention Laws Third and Fourth Grade Promotion Timeline
- Teach for America –Ignite Program
- Memphis Teacher Residency Reading Specialist Program: will try to send one teacher from each school

Motion: To formally enter into an agreement with The Marston Group, PLC to provide auditing services to the Promise Academy network. Motion seconded and approved.

Motion: To formally enter into an agreement with Power Solutions, LLC to provide student recruitment plans and communications support to the Promise Academy network. Motion seconded and approved.

Note: Promise Academy Spring Hill will not be able to be a potential campus location for the Tennessee Career Academy. Promise does not own the building and the Tennessee Career Academy does not have its own agreement with the TN Public Charter School Commission.
